BLUE RAIDER FASTBREAK POINTS

- MT is undefeated at home this season at 4-0 and holds a 19-2 record at Murphy Center over the past two seasons. The Blue Raiders have won 17 straight regular-season home games.
- The men's and women's teams have combined for 31 straight regular-season home wins, which ranks sixth nationally. Stanford (85), Baylor (45), Kansas (35), Syracuse (33) and Ohio State (32) are ahead of MT.
- MT has won three of the last five meetings against SEC opponents.
- Marcos Knight has scored double figures in eight of the last nine games and all but two games this season.
- MT has beaten an SEC opponent in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history.
- After starting last season 4-0 and with the 5-1 start this season, MT got off to its best back-to-back starts since the 1986-87 and 1987-88 seaons. MT started 1986-87 5-0 and 1987-88 6-1.
- Raymond Cintron scored a career-high 22 points at Akron on Dec. 2 and Marcos Knight matched his career-high with 21 points in the contest. Knight also scored 21 at Savannah State on Nov. 13.
- The 97 points against Alabama State in the season-opener marked the most since MT scored 109 against Houston Baptist on Feb. 13, 2010.
- MT was unanimously picked to win the Sun Belt East Division this year by the league's head coaches.
- Four Blue Raiders earned preseason all-conference honors. Marcos Knight was named to the first team, JT Sulton and Bruce Massey to the second team and Raymond Cintron to the third team.
- Raymond Cintron was rated as the No. 39 shooter in the country according to CBSSports.com's Top 50 shooters.

LAST TIME OUT

Middle Tennessee kept it close against Belmont through the first half, but a 16-3 run to open the second stanza propelled the Bruins to a 64-49 win on Thursday at the Curb Event Center.

The Blue Raiders shot a season-low 28.6 percent from the field, while Belmont hit 50 percent of its shots. JT Sulton neared a double-double for MT with nine points and eight rebounds and Jason Jones added eight points. MT owned a 22-8 advantage in bench production and a 19-9 margin in second-chance points, but the Bruins' 36-24 advantage in the paint proved to be the difference. Belmont also out-rebounded the Blue Raiders, 39-37, and blocked seven shots.

HOME SWEET HOME

MT has continued to defend its home court this season after finishing 15-2 in Murphy Center last year. The Blue Raiders are 4-0 at home this year and haven't lost a regular-season game in Murphy Center since Nov. 20, 2011 when MT dropped an 87-84 double overtime decision to Belmont. That's 17 straight regular-season home victories for the Blue Raiders. MT is now 19-2 over the last two seasons in Murphy Center.

BENCH PRODUCTION

With 10 of the top 12 scorers returning from last season's team, it's no surprise that MT has a deep bench. The Blue Raider bench has outscored its opponent in every game this season, currently owning a 326-138 advantage.

The Blue Raiders have out-rebounded their opponent in seven of 10 contests this season. MT currently owns a 367-322 rebounding advantage, an average of 36.7 compared to 32.2.

TAKING ON THE SEC

With the win over Ole Miss on Dec. 8, MT has now beaten an SEC opponent in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history. The Blue Raiders defeated both Tennessee and Ole Miss last season. It also marked the first win over an SEC opponent in Murphy Center since a 93-90 overtime victory against Vanderbilt on Feb. 1, 1995. MT is now 1-1 against the SEC this year (Lost to No. 10 Florida on Nov. 18) and has won three of the last five meetings against SEC opponents.

TEAM OF THE WEEK

Middle Tennessee was named the Mid-Major Team of the Week by ESPN.com's Myron Medcalf on Dec. 13. The Blue Raiders earned the nod after knocking off Ole Miss, 65-62.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES

Shawn Jones raked in the Sun Belt and Tennessee Sports Writers Association Player of the Week awards on Nov. 27 after posting a pair of double-doubles against UCF and Texas Southern. He tallied 18 points and 13 rebounds, both career-highs, in a 75-61 win over UCF. The Hialeah, Fla., native followed that up by setting a new career-high with 21 points and also grabbed 12 boards in a 79-52 victory over Texas Southern. For the week, Jones averaged 19.5 points and 12.5 rebounds while shooting 66.7 percent from the field. He is the only Blue Raider to start every game this season.

KERMIT DAVIS FILE



In 10 seasons at Middle Tennessee, Kermit Davis has established himself as one of the most successful men's basketball coaches in program history, and he's done so while rebuilding a program that had fallen on hard times. Prior

to Davis' hiring in April 2002, Middle Tennessee had endured losing seasons in three of the four previous years and was one season removed from a 5-22 campaign, the worst in school history. The Blue Raiders registered four straight winning seasons under Davis to start his Blue Raider coaching career, making him one of only two of the 19 Middle Tennessee men's basketball coaches to start a Blue Raider career with four straight winning campaigns. The other was Bruce Stewart. The Blue Raiders' game against Indiana State (11/30/06) was Davis' 125th at Middle Tennessee. Davis' record after 125 games at Middle Tennessee was 71-54, making him the second-winningest coach in program history after 125 games. Davis first on the all-time Middle Tennessee wins list with 187.

DAVIS BECOMES MT'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACH

Kermit Davis became Middle Tennessee's all-time winningest coach after securing his 165th victory with the Blue Raiders 71-66 win over FIU on Dec. 29. Davis surpassed former coach Jimmy Earle, who previously held the record with 164 wins.

DAVIS SECURES CAREER WIN 250...TWICE

Kermit Davis secured his 250th win as a head coach when Middle Tennessee beat Louisiana-Lafayette, 83-76 (1/29/09) at Murphy Center. Davis then secured his 250th Division I win against Marshall in MT's 86-78 NIT victory on March 13, 2012. He won 66 games in three years as a junior college head coach and currently has 324 career wins.

DAVIS NOTCHES MT WIN NO. 150

Davis recorded his 150th win as the head coach at Middle Tennessee with the 69-60 win over rival Western Kentucky on Feb. 10, 2011. Davis is just the second coach in program history to reach the milestone.

DAVIS NOTCHES MILESTONE WIN

Davis became the second-fastest to reach 100 wins at Middle Tennessee when the Blue Raiders upset South Alabama, 82-73, in the semifinals of the 2008 Sun Belt Championships. Davis reached the milestone in his 182nd career game. The 100 wins under Davis in his first six seasons represent the best six-year total for the program since 1988-93 (105 wins). The Blue Raiders averaged 17 wins in Davis' first six seasons, which is the second-best wins average for any Middle Tennessee coach after six seasons.

DAVIS AMONG COACHING LEADERS

Davis joined Bruce Stewart as the only head coaches in program history to begin their Blue Raider careers with four straight winning seasons. He currently has 187 wins and is the program's all-time winningest coach. Davis also is third in winning percentage (.579) among Blue Raider men's basketball coaches with a minimum of 50 games coached, trailing only Jimmy Earle (.614), and Bruce Stewart (.648).

DAVIS AMONG SUN BELT'S ALL-TIME WINNINGEST COACHES

Davis is second in all-time victories among active Sun Belt coaches with 99, trailing only Ronnie Arrow in his second stint at South Alabama. Overall, Davis is among the league's all-time winningest coaches in Sun Belt play with 99 victories and is fourth all-time. The all-time Sun Belt wins leader is Gene Bartow, who won 111 games during his 12 seasons at former conference member UAB. These totals only include regular-season conference wins.

MT AMONG SBC'S BEST UNDER DAVIS

Middle Tennessee is one of four league members (WKU, North Texas, Louisiana) to play in multiple SBC Championship games (2003, 2008) since 2003, and it is just one of two SBC members (WKU) to reach the quarterfinals in each of the last nine years. Middle Tennessee, North Texas and WKU are the only SBC schools to reach the league's semifinals four times in the last seven years.




