Friday's Action

Middle Tennessee's (13-4, 8-1 Sun Belt) school record tying eight match win streak was snapped last Thursday with a 3-2 loss at North Texas. The Mean Green's 2-0 loss at Western Kentucky last Sunday kept the door open for the Blue Raiders to secure a regular season title. If the Blue Raiders knock off their arch rival WKU, it would be the first outright regular season title in school history and the second title since sharing a championship with North Texas in 2004.

Tidbits

- Middle Tennessee is receiving votes in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) South Poll.
- The Raiders have scored 12 goals in the first 15 minutes of action this year.
- Offensively, the Blue Raiders are third in the NCAA behind Penn State and Dayton in scoring offense. Middle Tennessee is averaging 3.12 goals per game.
- MT has out tallied their last 13 opponents, 38-to-14.
- Paige Goeglein ranks first nationally with eight game-winning goals and is ninth in the NCAA with 14 goals scored
- Five Blue Raiders have reached double digits in points: Paige Goeglein (32), Whitney Jorgenson (23), Kate Loye (20), Regina Thomas (16) and Tori Hawkins (12).

About the Lady Toppers

Looking to continue a five-game unbeaten streak, Western Kentucky (11-4-2, 6-1-2) travels to Murfreesboro in the regular season finale for both squads. Senior Amanda Buechel and freshman Lauren Moats have led a balanced WKU attack in conference play with five goals each. The offensive success is not limited to forwards and midfielders. Reigning Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Week Ali Stahlke has scored in consecutive games for the Lady Toppers, including the game-winner in a 2-0 victory against North Texas last week. The WKU defense has allowed just four goals in conference play and has a 0.42 GAA average with freshman Nikki Hall between the pipes.

WKU Series

The series with WKU and MT is even at 4-4-5. The Blue Raiders have dropped two consecutive matches to WKU. Last season, the Toppers edged MT, 1-0, in the regular season finale before handing MT a 1-nil loss in the Sun Belt Tournament. Prior to last year's regular season loss, the Blue Raiders have won four home matches in Murfreesboro.

What's at Stake

Middle Tennessee currently sits in second place, one point behind North Texas. The Mean Green's regular season is over, so a MT win on Friday would give Middle Tennessee its first outright regular season title in school history. The Blue Raiders shared a regular season SBC Championship with North Texas in 2004. A loss would mean the Blue Raiders could potentially drop as low as third place depending on the outcome of the FIU/Florida Atlantic match. A Panthers win over FAU would move FIU to second and the Raiders to third.

Blue Raiders Offense Among the Nation's Best

MT has one of the most prolific scoring attacks in the country. The Raiders are number three in the country with 3.12 goals scored per game, ranking only behind Penn State and Dayton. MT has scored three-plus goals in nine matches.

Running thru the Rankings

Through 10 weeks of action, Middle Tennessee leads the Sun Belt in five categories. The Blue Raiders have amassed a league-best 144 points, 53 goals, 3.12 gpg, 38 assists and 2.24 apg. Nationally, MT has several players in top-50 national categories. Paige Goeglein is first with a school-record eight game-winning goals. Goeglein is ninth nationally with 14 goals scored and is 18th in the NCAA with 32 points. Senior Whitney Jorgenson is 49th nationally with seven assists through 17 matches.

Starting Strong

Middle Tennessee is off to the school's best start since the 2006 campaign. The Blue Raiders' record of 13-4 is only second to the 14-2 start in 2006.

Jorgenson Inking Her Name in the Record Books

Whitney Jorgenson is continuing to ink her name in the MT record books. The Overland Park, Kan., product is fifth in assists (20) and ranks seventh in shot percentage (.144). She is tied for sixth with seven game-winning goals, sixth in minutes played (5,770) and eighth with 64 career points.

Seniority Matters

The Blue Raiders senior class has made a valuable impact for Middle Tennessee. According to College Soccer 360, the squad is tied as the 36th best senior class this year. The tandem of Charity Blair, Jessica Gilchrist, Paige Goeglein, Whitney Jorgenson, Allison Stallard and Regina Thomas have notched a record of 48-28-5 (.631) during their time at MT. The senior squad also made the only NCAA Tournament appearance in the school's history in 2010. In total, the duo has combined for 69 goals and 52 assists for 190 points. The six seniors have logged 29,255 minutes during their four year careers.

Senior Night

The MT Department of Athletics will honor all six Blue Raider seniors immediately following the match. Middle Tennessee has recorded a mark of 0-1-3 in the past four years on Senior Night. MT's last victory in a home regular season finale was a 2-1 thriller against North Texas on Oct. 28, 2007. MT last defeated WKU on Senior Night, 3-1, on Oct. 27, 2006.

Thomas Continues Record Pace

Earlier this year, senior Regina Thomas entered the top-10 in career goals at MT. The forward netted her 21st and 22nd career goals against Belmont to move into 10th all-time. Against North Texas, she managed her 23rd goal to move in a tie with Emily Carter and Paige Goeglein. The forward ranks fifth all-time in shot percentage (.164), sixth in career assists (19) and is tied for eighth in shots on goal (91).

Start Spreading the Scores

Middle Tennessee has 13 players with goals this season. Of those 13, 11 have reached multiple goals this season. MT has five that have reached four goals or more this season: Paige Goeglein (14), Whitney Jorgenson (8), Kate Loye (7), Regina Thomas (5) and Tori Hawkins (4).

RPI Rankings

There are currently three Sun Belt programs in the top-100 of the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI). North Texas leads the league with a 60 ranking, while MT is second at 76. FIU is third in the league with a mark of 93.

The First Half Raiders

Scoring in the first half has been the mantra for the Blue Raider program this season. Middle Tennessee has outscored its opponents 29-to-11 in the opening half. Therefore, 55 percent (29-of-53) of MT's goals this season have come from the opening half.

Dynamic Duo

Both goalkeepers for the Blue Raiders have been tremendous minding the net this season. Freshman Kelsey Brouwer holds a 8-2 record, saving 79 percent of goal attempts this season. The Franklin native holds a 1.10 Goals Against Average in 11 matches this season. Jessica Gilchrist has posted a 5-2 record in eight contests. The redshirt senior has given up just 10 goals, while notching 26 saves.

Backline Dominance

The defensive backline has been one of Middle Tennessee's most unheralded strong points this year. The Blue Raiders have allowed multiple goals only twice in the past six matches. The defensive line is led by seniors Allison Stallard and Charity Blair, who have both logged approximately 11,821 minutes of experience. Stallard scored the equalizing goal in MT's 2-1 victory over USA on Oct. 16.

Goeglein Garnering More Accolades

Senior midfielder Paige Goeglein continues to rack up weekly honors. The Fort Wayne, Ind., product earned her second Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week award on Oct. 15 after scoring her first career hat trick in a 3-1 victory over Troy. Goeglein made a critical assist in MT's 2-1 win over South Alabama as the Raiders tied a school-record eight consecutive win. The senior ranks ninth nationally with 14 goals this season and is the NCAA leader with eight game-winning goals. Also in the same week, Goeglein racked up the College Sports Madness Sun Belt Player of the Week award and became the first Middle Tennessee soccer player to be recognized as the Tennessee Sports Writers Association Women's Soccer Player of the Week.

CSM Recognizes Whitney Jorgenson

National online pundit College Sports Madness named Whitney Jorgenson the CSM Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week for Oct. 8. The senior forward scored MT's two goals in the 2-nil shutout at Louisiana. Jorgenson is second on the team with 23 points. She leads the team with seven assists.

Goeglein named to CS360 Primetime Performer Honor Roll

Senior Paige Goeglein garnered national recognition on Oct. 3 for her game-winning performances against FIU and Florida Atlantic. College Soccer 360 named Goeglein to the weekly CS360 Primetime Performer Honor Roll for week 7. The Fort Wayne, Ind., product tallied the golden goal against FIU and came back on Sunday with a double-overtime clincher at Florida Atlantic. Goeglein's two golden goals give her a single season record six, breaking the previous best of Shan Jones' eight in 2008.

Loye Garners Recognition

Freshman Kate Loye earned her first honor by the Sun Belt on Oct. 1. The freshman totaled two goals and two assists for six points as MT defeated FIU and Florida Atlantic. Loye had the game-winning assist against FIU and also the assist in Paige Goeglein's golden goal against the Owls. Loye is third on the team with 15 points.

Goeglein and Hartshorn Sweep Honors

Paige Goeglein and Emily Hartshorn grabbed weekly offensive and defensive player of the week honors on Sept. 4 by the Sun Belt Conference. Goeglein accumulated four points, including a goal and two assists in MT's 7-1 drubbing of ETSU. Hartshorn provided stout defense throughout the weekend as MT gave up just three goals on the weekend.

Preseason Picks

Middle Tennessee was picked to finish third in the Sun Belt Conference for the 2012 season. The Blue Raiders were slated to finish behind preseason favorite North Texas and second place FIU. Voting resulted in a tie for MT as they were picked third along with archrival Western Kentucky. Three Blue Raiders grabbed preseason All-Conference accolades. Seniors Regina Thomas, Paige Goeglein and Allison Stallard all picked up preseason honors as voted on by the league coaches.
